Educational Writing	Any kind of media, communication, publicity or PR work which is intended to educate or inform to public or Master Gardeners.	-writing for Growing, Gardener's Pen -Posts on our Facebook page
Educational Event Planning	Involvement in any kind of Educational Event (includes set-up and clean up, event planning meeting attendance and preparation, etc.)	- LCMGA Seminars - Beevent Pollinator Conference - talk series in Albany, Sweet Home, Lebanon
Master Gardener Class Mentor	Assuming the role of mentor for MG classes or training	-Mentor, including at home communication & class prep
Fundraiser	Involvement in any kind of fundraising activity.	-Garden Tour
Extension Office Support	Volunteering to help in the Extension Office.	-Office Support
MG Association	Volunteering for the association, holding an office in the association, attending association meetings, etc.	- LCMGA/OMGA Board Meeting attendance, prep -Attending association business meetings -general committee work
Other Approved Projects	Any other volunteer work which is part of an approved project by Elizabeth or Brooke.
