

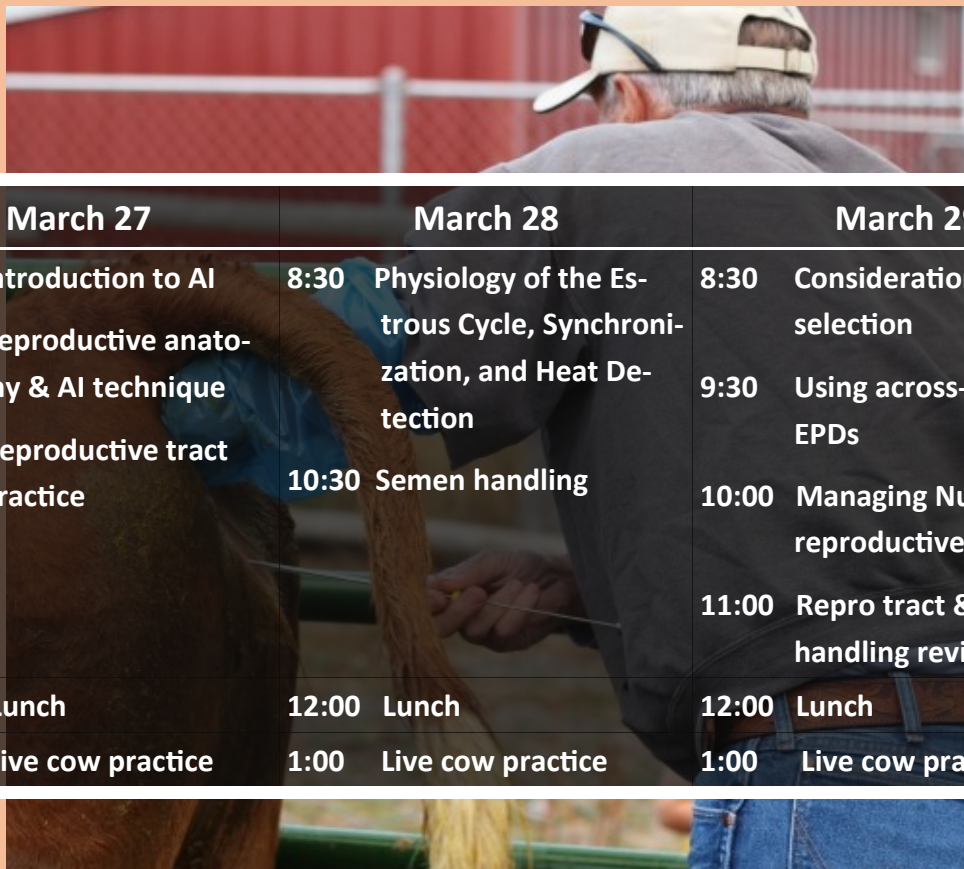
Cattle Artificial Insemination School
