Documentation of this meeting can be provided by the faculty members signing this sheet after the meeting. This form should be returned to Talley Richardson after completion.

You are expected to attend the faculty seminar series (Monday-Wednesday-Friday, noon-1 pm, GILB 324, weeks 2-4) in order to further explore your research opportunities. Additionally, some faculty members may be happy to discuss the possibility of a rotation in their lab prior to making a final decision.
