Dear Senators Wyden and Merkley, Representatives DeFazio, Blumenauer, Walden, Schrader, and Bonamici:

Oregon's public university presidents strongly oppose the unfortunate decision to end DACA--the Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals--program. DACA's repeal is a broken promise that must be corrected for the benefit of not only the livelihood and future of these individuals, but the enrichment of our universities, state, society, and economy. Congress has shown a bipartisan willingness to support DREAMers and multiple solutions are currently pending in Congress to address this problem. The public university presidents urge Congress to take immediate action to remedy this decision by the administration.

DACA was implemented in 2012 to allow undocumented youth a semblance of protection while in the United States and these children were brought to the U.S. by parents or relatives prior to their own age of consent. They have grown up in America, attended American schools, and are loyal, hard-working young people contributing to the health and well-being of Americans.

DACA imposes rigorous requirements--including a \$500 fee every two years--for permits to remain in the United States as long as the recipient is working, attending a college or university, or serving in the Armed Forces. DACA recipients find themselves in the United States through no voluntary act of their own and, in many instances, could be torn from lives they have created and deported to countries of which they have no recognizable memory.

We urge you to act swiftly to ensure continued access to DACA protections for eligible individuals and avoid undue disruption in their lives. Please let us know if we can be of assistance in this important endeavor.
